

The MEP Digital Supply Chain Maturity Survey

- Know your business.

For many small and medium-sized companies, the unprecedented role of technology and data in today's manufacturing environment may seem intimidating. However, the Hollings Manufacturing Extension Partnership, in cooperation with the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) have developed a brief survey to provide manufacturers with a better understanding of their digital supply chain maturity.



The digital future is here.

Following completion of the survey, companies will be able to engage their home-state MEP organization for further training and education. From building awareness to hands-on training and guidance, resources have been created with input from industry experts and experienced professionals. Companies who participate in this survey will also be eligible to participate in networking and mentorship programs being developed through the MEP Digital Supply Chain Network program.

Each company completing the survey or assessment will receive:

- A report outlining strengths and areas for improvement relevant to their company's readiness to participate in the digital supply chain. This report will be provided by the home-state MEP organization in an email following completion of the survey.
- A bench-marking report for your company, as well as an overall industry benchmark report upon completion of the survey period. Early survey participants will receive their bench-marking report after a sufficient number of manufacturers have completed the survey. This will ensure results are relevant and meaningful.
