

Writing a Successful Workforce Training Grant

It's your money...

The Workforce Training Fund (WTF) provides money to Massachusetts businesses to train and develop their employees. This Fund is financed entirely by a portion of the unemployment insurance paid by Massachusetts' employers. If your company pays unemployment insurance, you are eligible to participate in the training grant program.

Associated Industries of Massachusetts (A.I.M.) and Commonwealth Corporation have created a workshop designed to familiarize employers with the variety of Workforce Training Fund programs available. At these sessions, you will learn the key to writing a successful application for a Workforce Training Grant.
